

EXAMPLE: PAGE META INFO

Each page in a website has page-level meta information that Tweak can manage.

```
<div id="sitename">Lorem</div>
<div id="pagetitle">Lorem</div>
<div id="description">Lorem</div>
```

EXAMPLE: STANDARD NAV

The 2nd item in your list defines your standard nav item. Classes for first, last, and selected aren't required for importing but Tweak will add them dynamically so it helps to have styles defined for them.

```
<ul id="navtop">
  <li class="first">
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
  <li>
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
  <li class="selected">
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
  <li class="last">
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
</ul>
```

EXAMPLE: SIBLING NAV

Sibling nav is a list of links to pages with the same parent as the current page. Substituting navchild as your class will get the pages that are children of the current page.

```
<ul id="navsibling">
  <li class="first">
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
  <li>
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
  <li class="last">
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
</ul>
```

EXAMPLE: NAV W/ SUBLEVEL

To include another level in your nav, e.g. for a drop-down nav, add a nested list to your 2nd nav item.

```
<ul id="navtop">
  <li class="first">
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
  <li>
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
    <ul>
      <li class="first">
        <a href="">Lorem</a>
      </li>
      <li>
        <a href="">Lorem</a>
      </li>
      <li class="selected">
        <a href="">Lorem</a>
      </li>
      <li class="last">
        <a href="">Lorem</a>
      </li>
    </ul>
  </li>
  <li class="selected">
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
  <li class="last">
    <a href="">Lorem</a>
  </li>
</ul>
```

EXAMPLE: CONTENT AREA

This will create two editable content areas. The CMS will insert the user-generated content into the div.

```
<div id="content">Lorem</div>
<div id="content_2">Lorem</div>
```

EXAMPLE: REUSABLE CONTENT AREA

Reusable content areas are great for footers or other areas where content will repeat across several or all pages.

```
<div id="reusablecontentarea">Lorem</div>
```

EXAMPLE: CRUMBTRAIL

This code will create a crumbtrail navigation that looks like this:

Location: Lorem > Ipsum > Dolor

```
<div id="crumbtrail">
  <span class="label">Location:</span>
  <a class="previous" href="">Lorem</a>
  <span class="separator"> &gt; </span>
  <a class="previous" href="">Ipsum</a>
  <span class="separator"> &gt; </span>
  <span class="current">Dolor</span>
</div>
```

EXAMPLE: NEWS

News listings are coded as follows:

```
<ul id="news">
  <li>
    <p class="title">
      <a href="">Lorem</a>
    </p>
    <div class="summary">Lorem</div>
  </li>
  <li>
    <p class="title">
      <a href="">Lorem</a>
    </p>
    <div class="summary">Lorem</div>
  </li>
</ul>
```

TIPS

- Dynamic elements can't be nested
- Declare a doctype and validate your code using validator.w3.org before importing
